Recipe of the month: Vanilla Cake

Ingredients

- 1 cup white sugar
- ½ cup unsalted butter
- 2 large eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 ½ cups all-purpose flour
- 1 3/4 teaspoons baking powder
- ½ cup milk

Recipe

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 F and grease and flour a 9-inc square cake pan
- 2. Add Cream sugar and butter together into a mixing bowl add eggs in one at a time beating briefly after each addition and mix in vanilla.
- In a separate bowl combine flour and baking powder add the wet ingredients and mix well than add milk and stir until smooth.
- 4. Pour the batter into the cake pan
- 5. Back in the oven until the top springs back when lightly touched about 30 to 40 minutes.
- 6. Remove from oven let it cool and then frost and add toping if you want.
