

Check the Screen Resolution on a Chromebook

Open the menu in the bottom right corner of the Chromebook screen by clicking on the battery symbol.

Select the Gear at the top of the pop-up window

Select Device from the menu on the left.

Select the arrow next to Displays.

Make sure the Resolution is 1366 x 768.

If the Resolution is incorrect you will need to adjust the slide bar to 100%.
